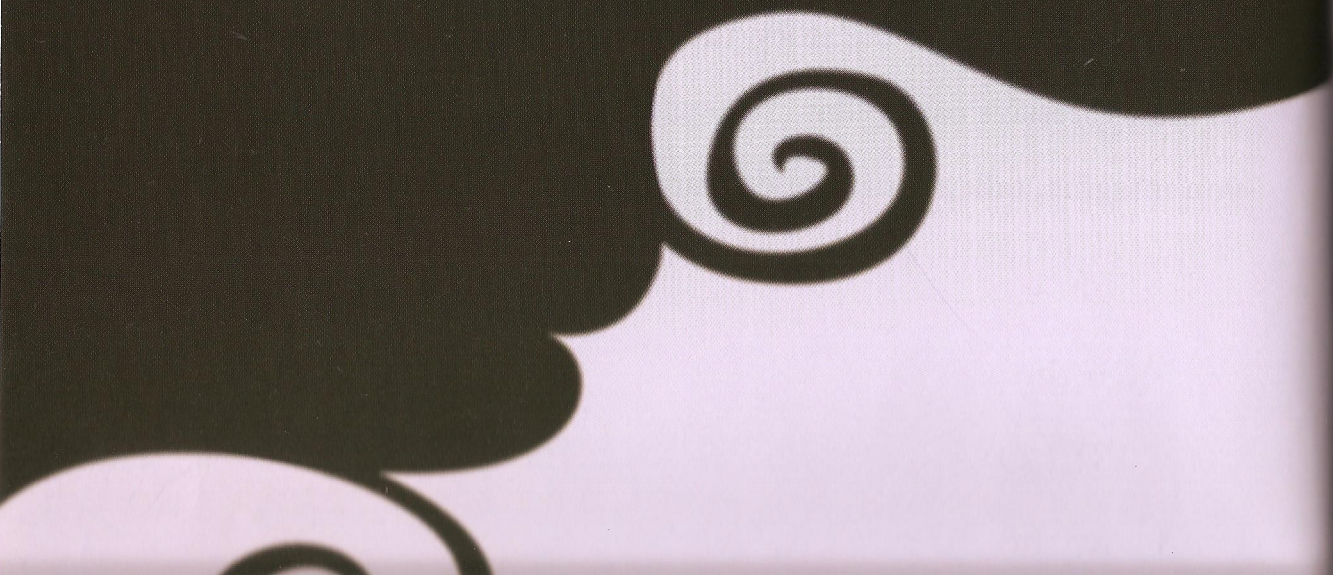
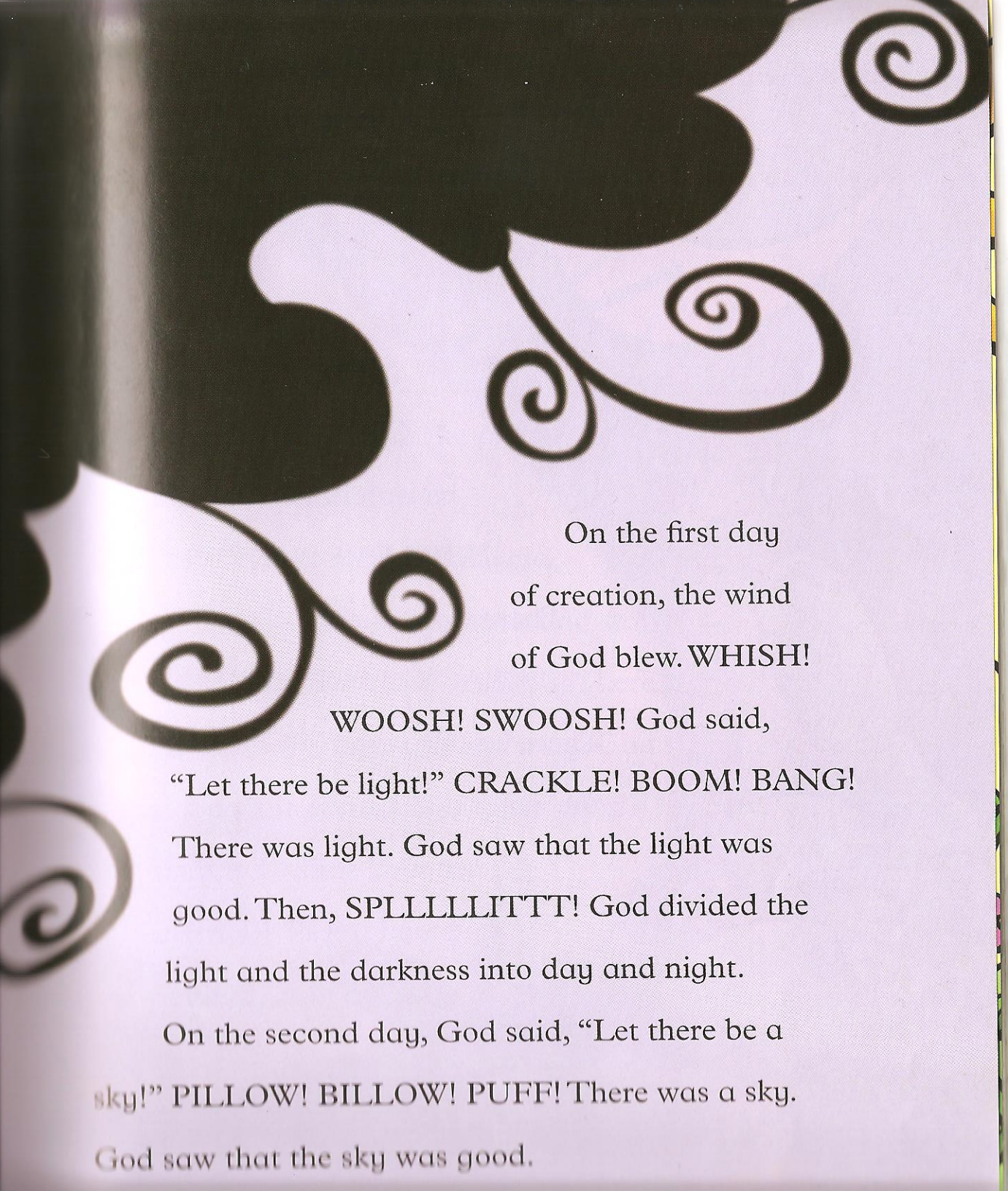


Creation

Before God created the world, there was nothing at all—except God.

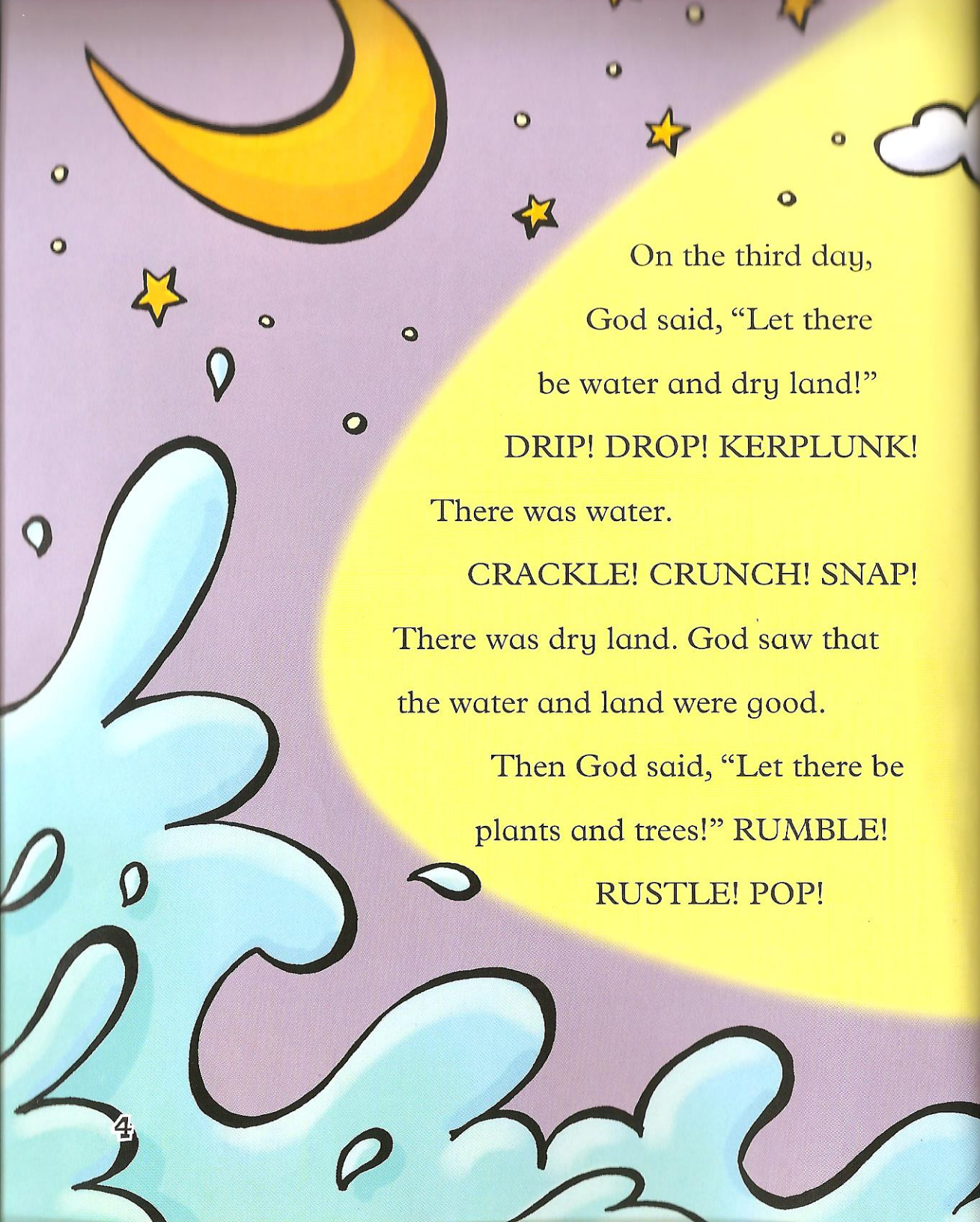




On the first day

DRIP! DROP! KERPLUNK!

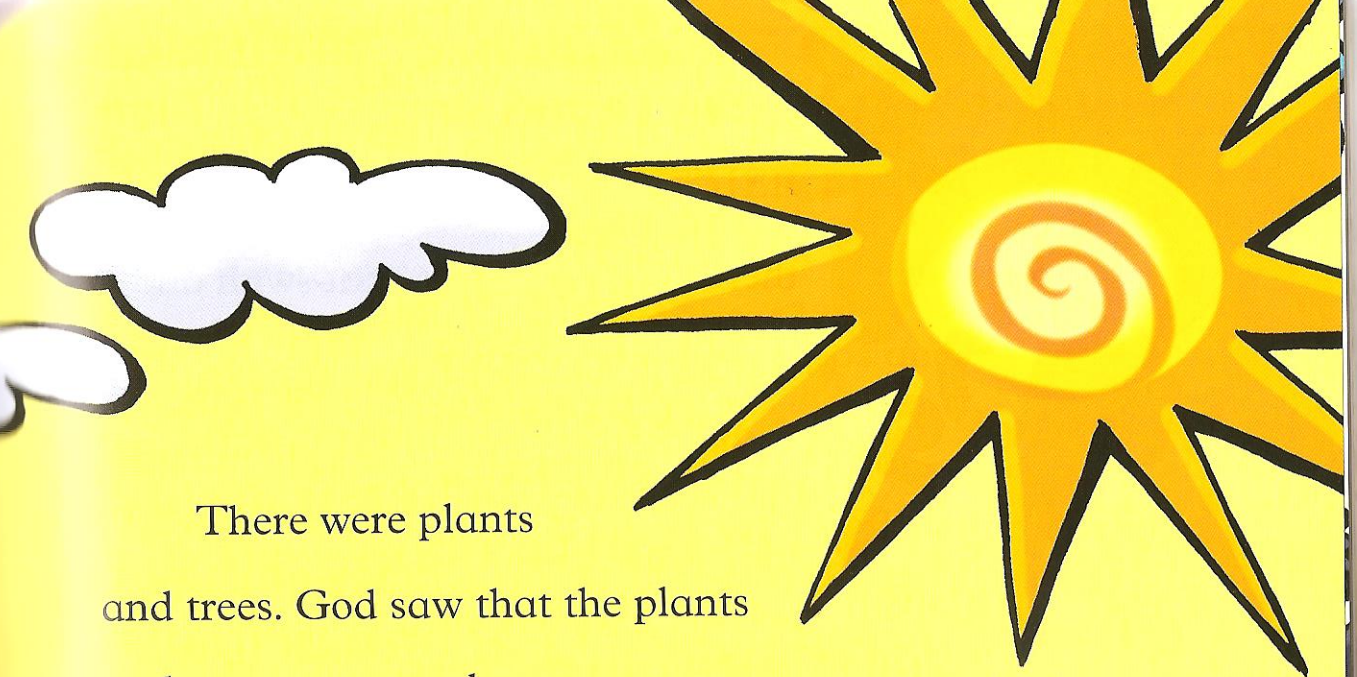
There was water.

plants and trees!" **RUMBLE!**

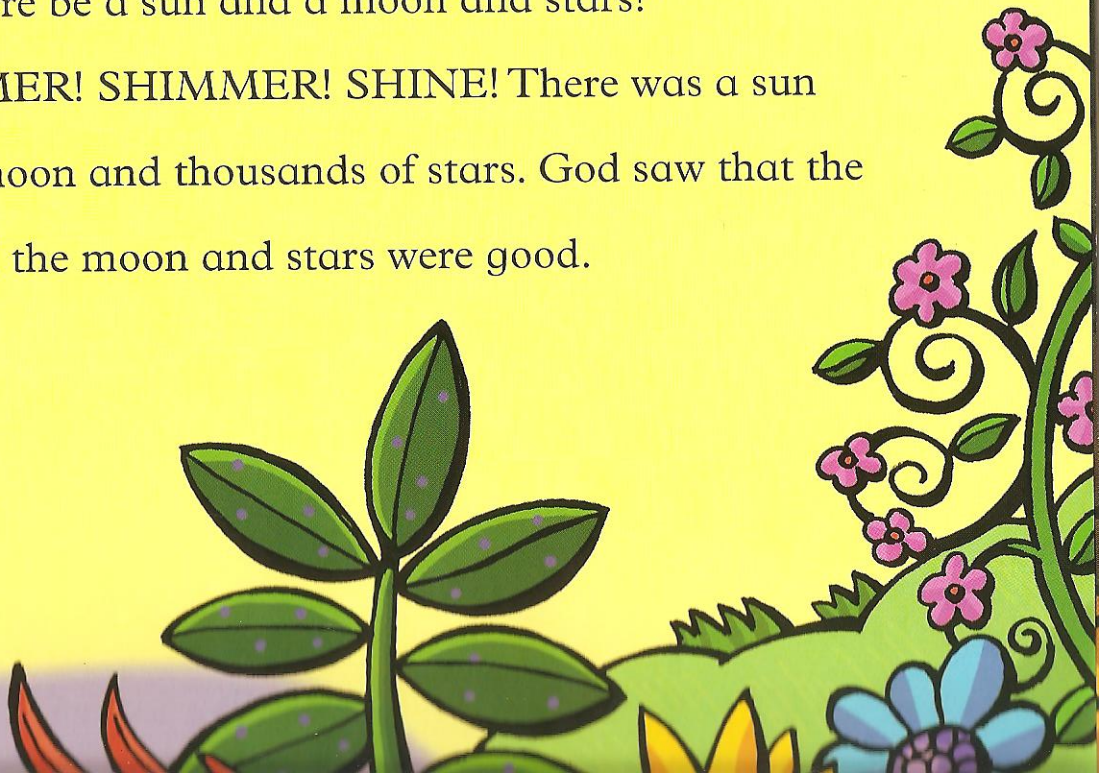
RUSTLE! POP!

sea animals and birds were good.

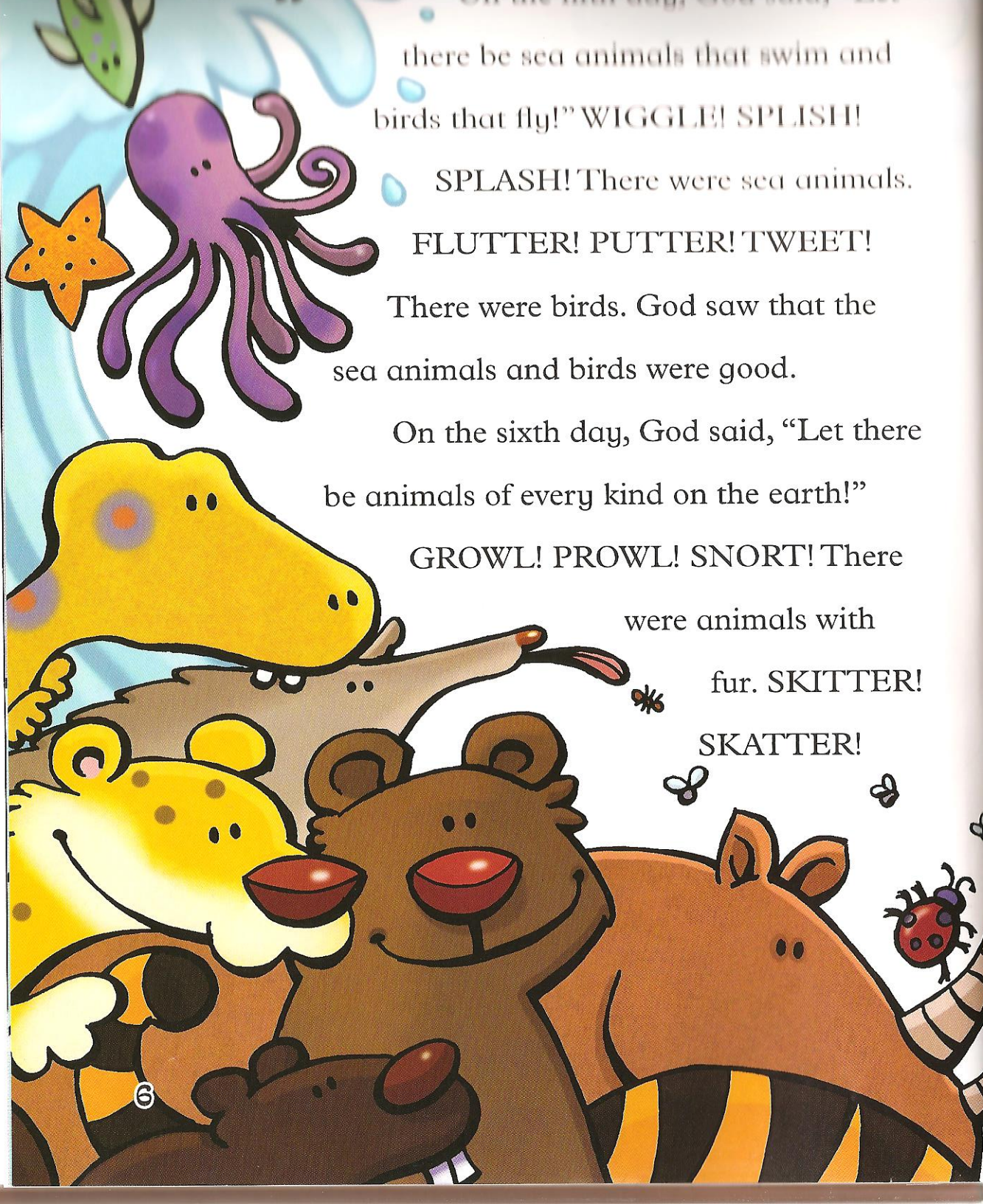
On the sixth day, God said, “Let there

SKATTER!

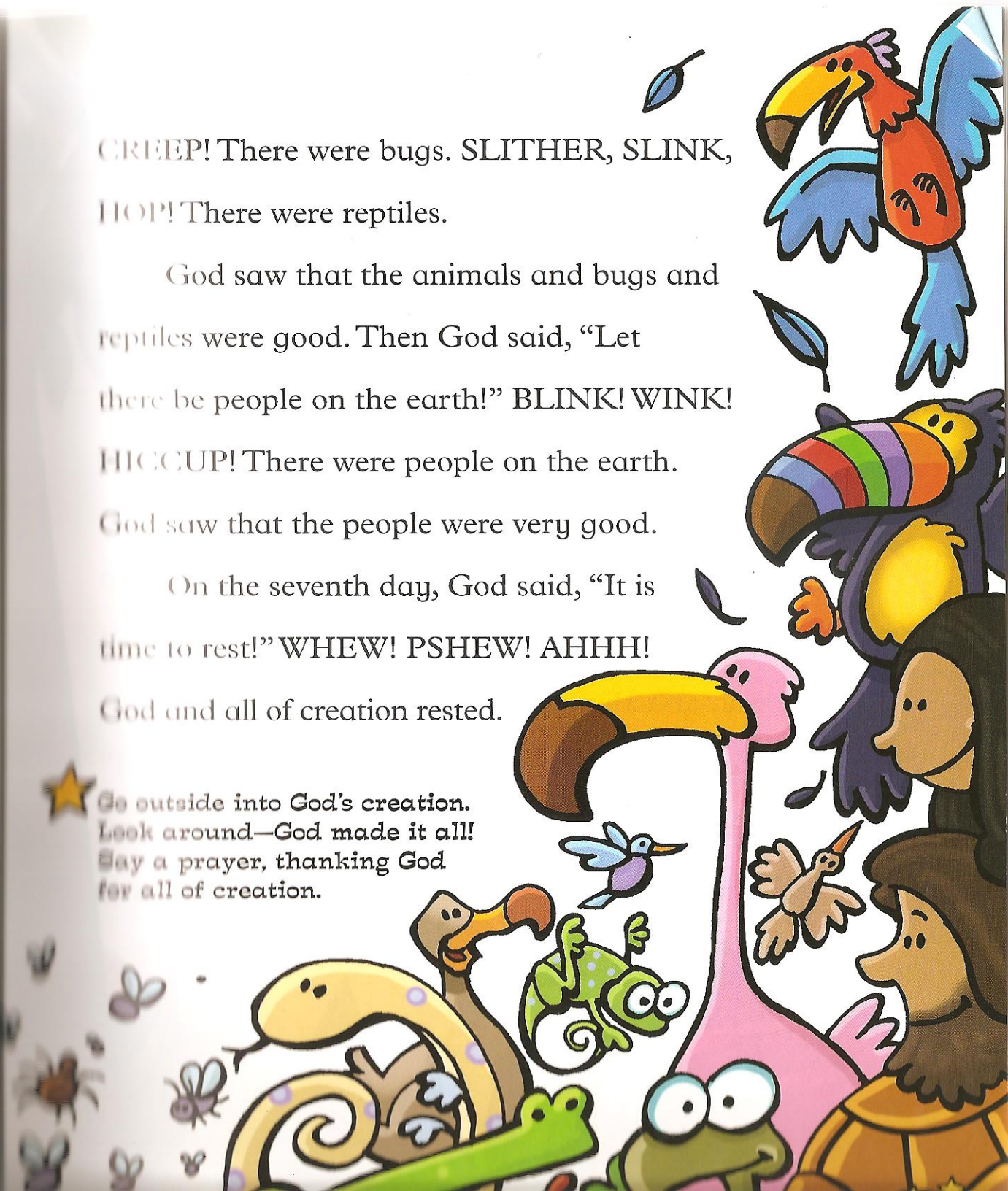


CREEP! There were bugs. SLITHER, SLINK,

God and all of creation rested.

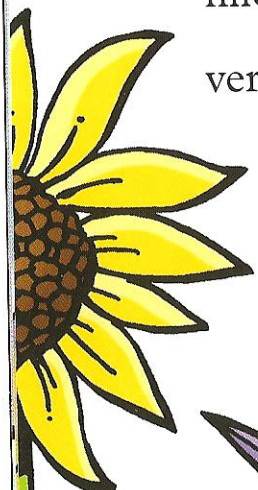

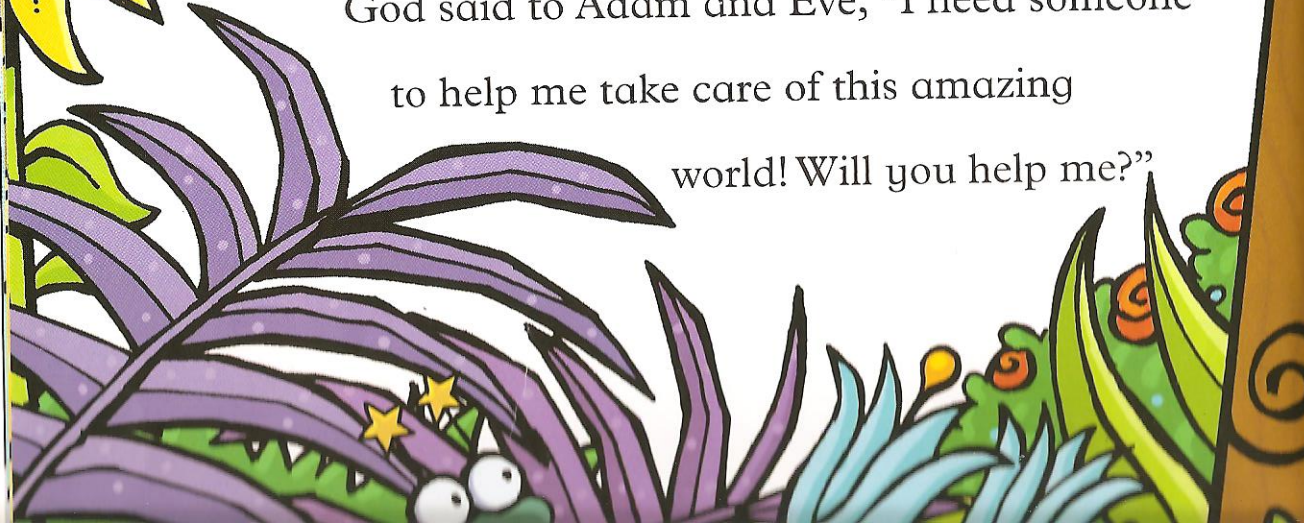
Adam and Eve

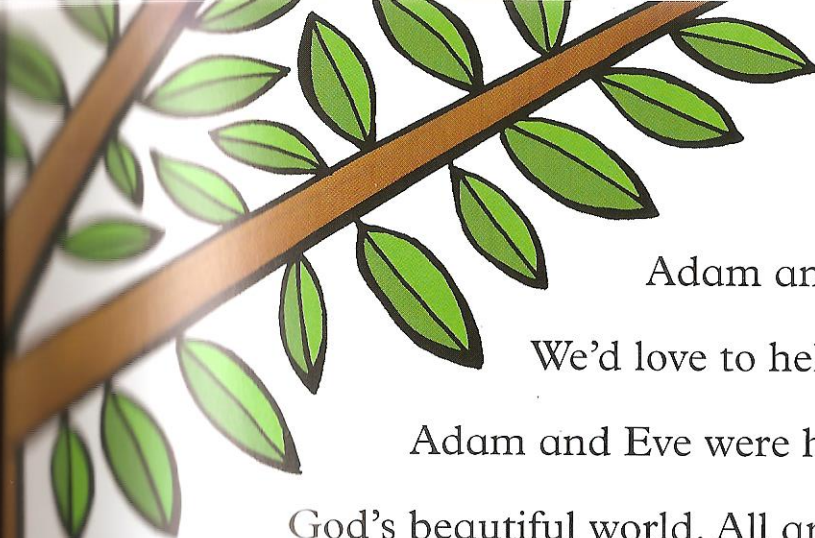
After creating the whole world, God looked around and was very happy. It was an incredible world filled with wonderful animals, plants, and included two very special people—a man and a woman.

God said to Adam and Eve, “I need someone to help me take care of this amazing world! Will you help me?”



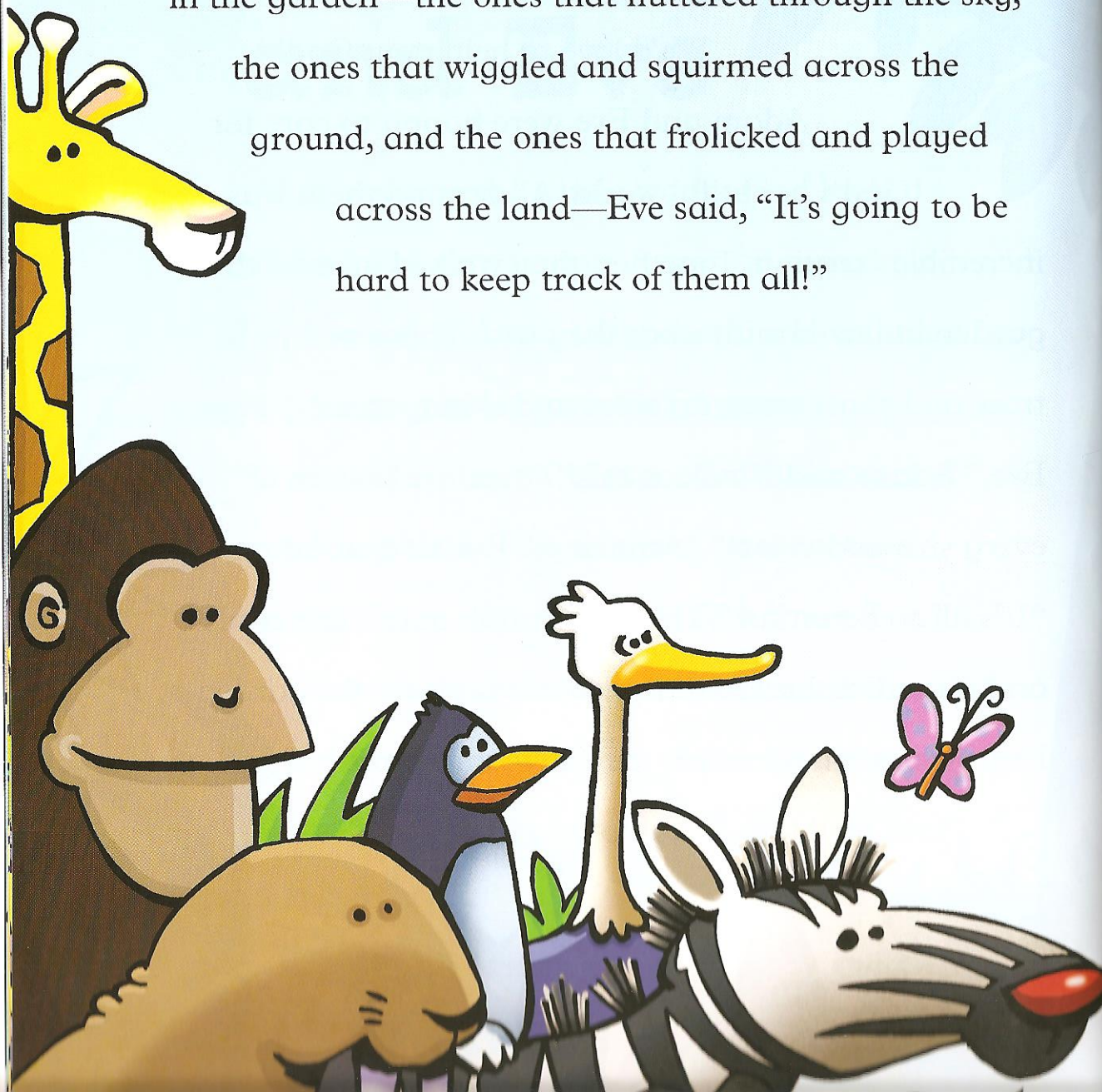


Adam and Eve said, "Sure!

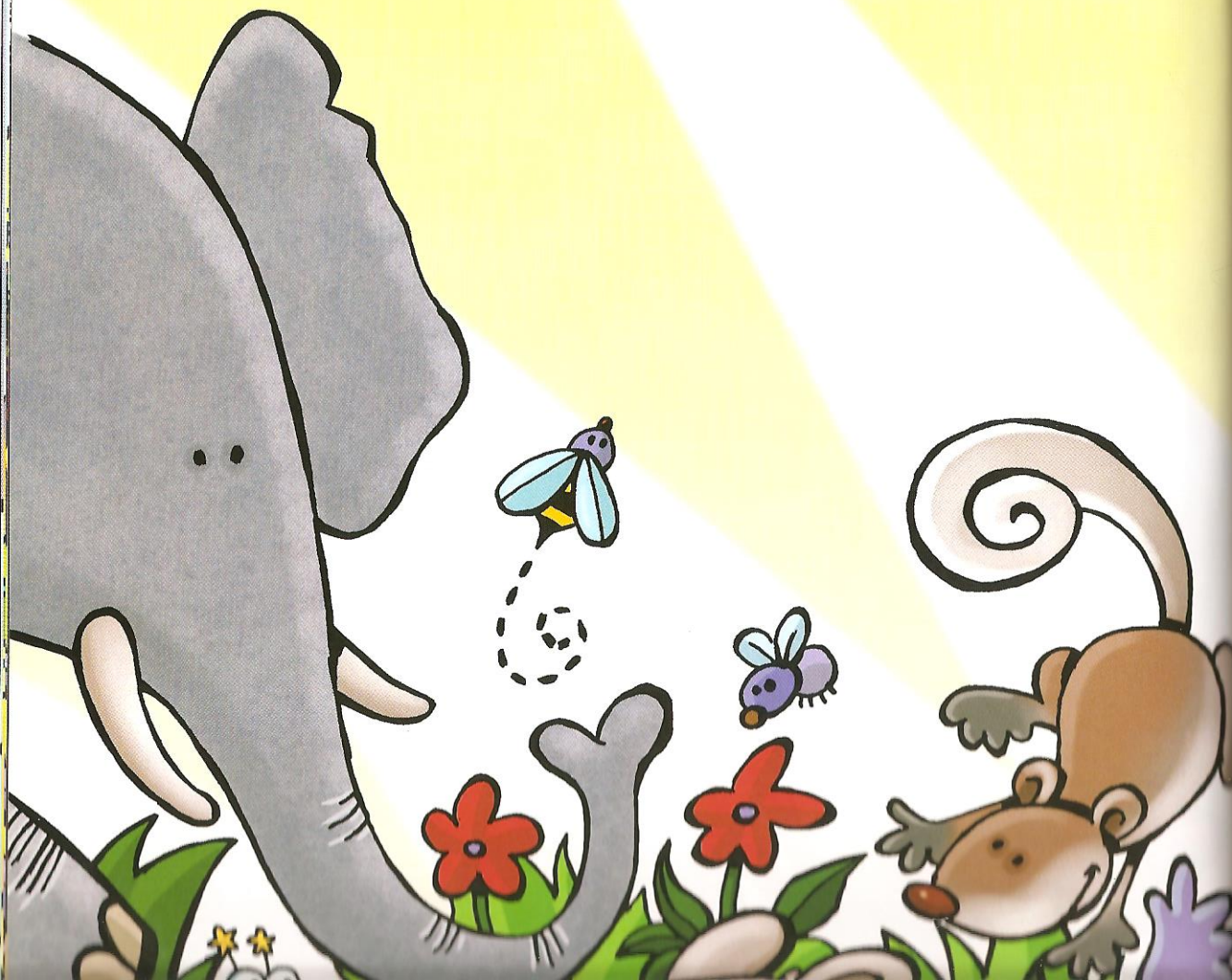

monkey and squirrel.”

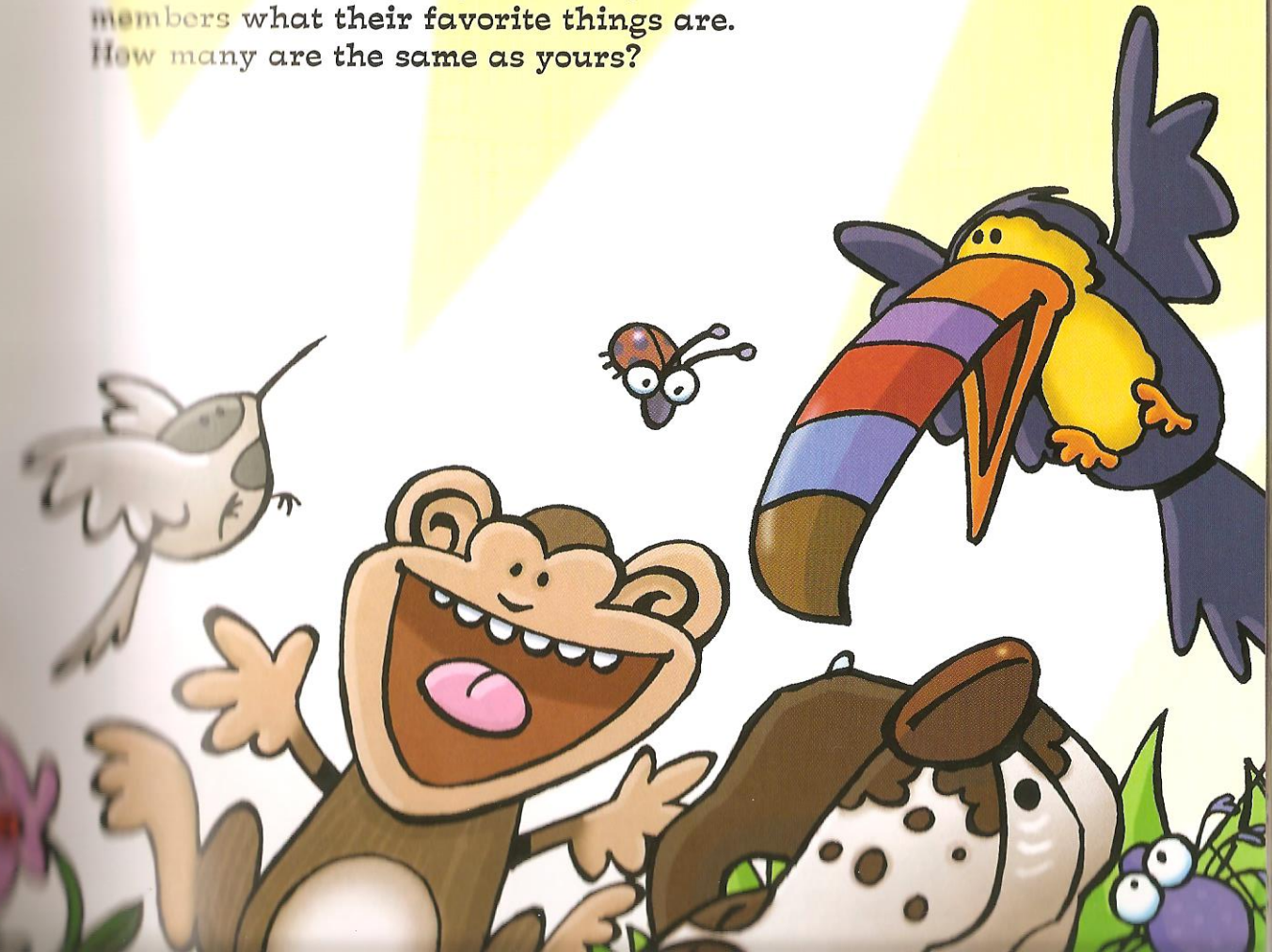

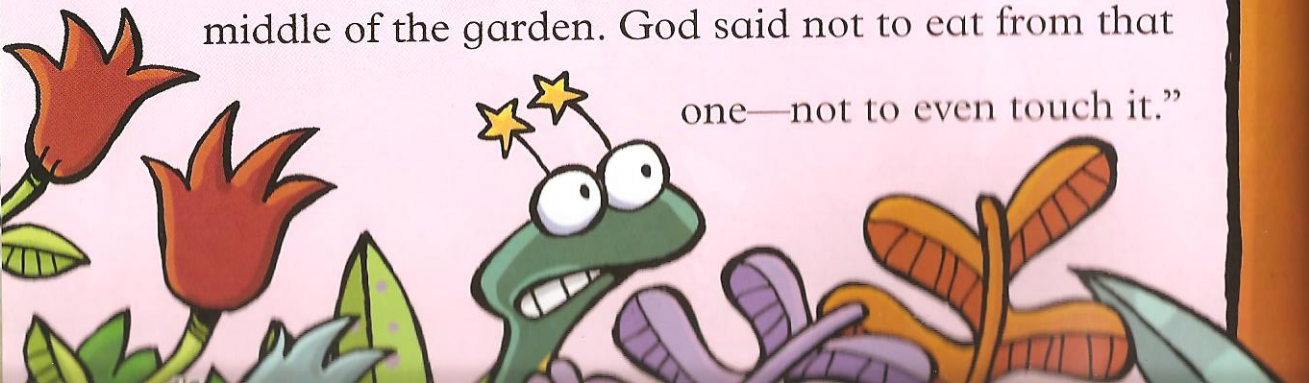


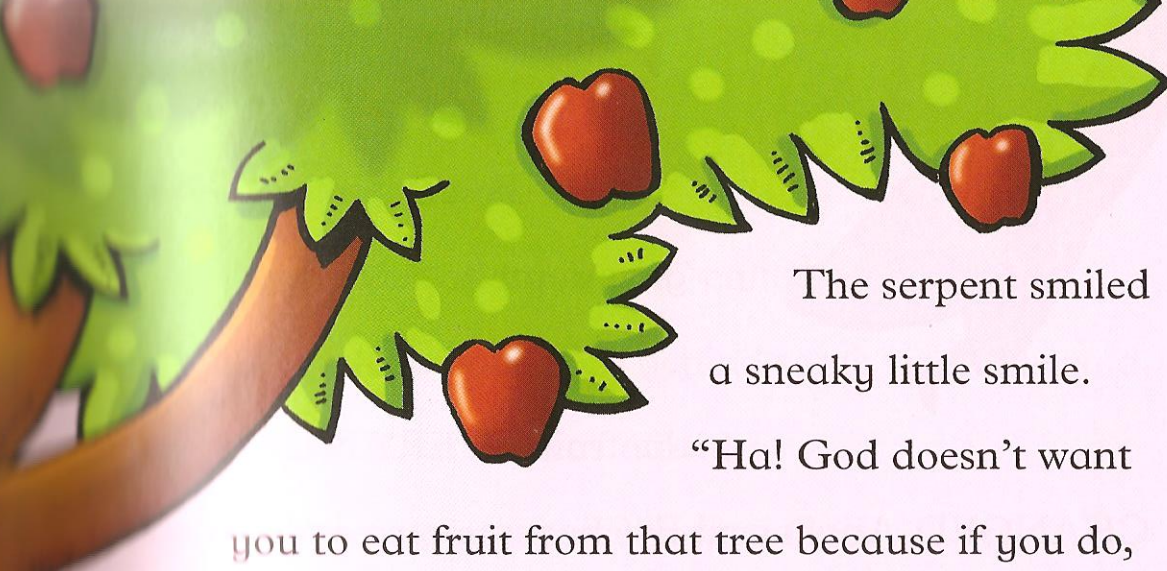
The First Sin

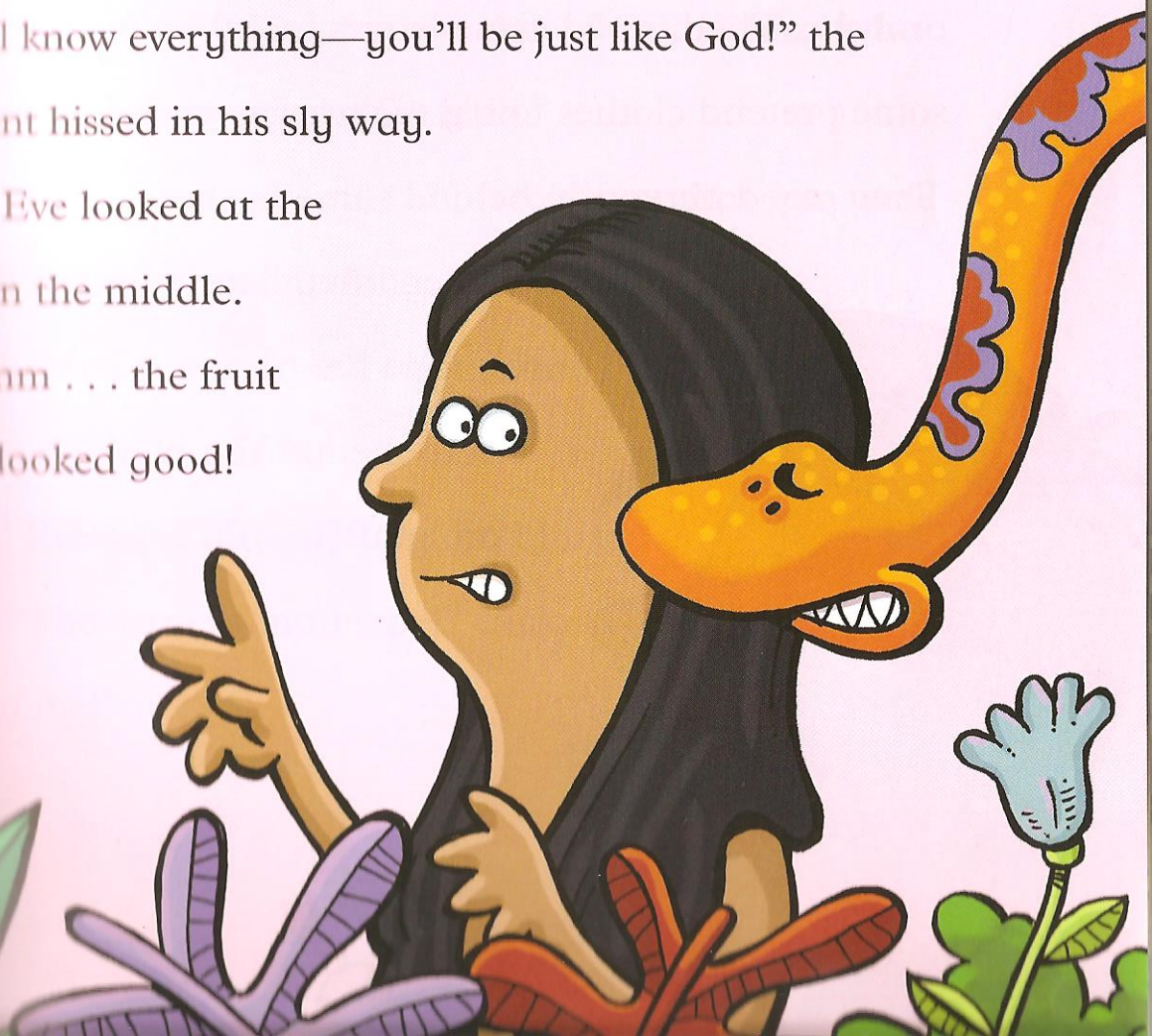


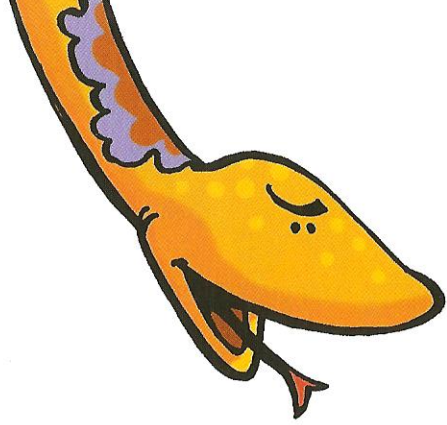


The serpent smiled

"Why were you afraid?" asked God.

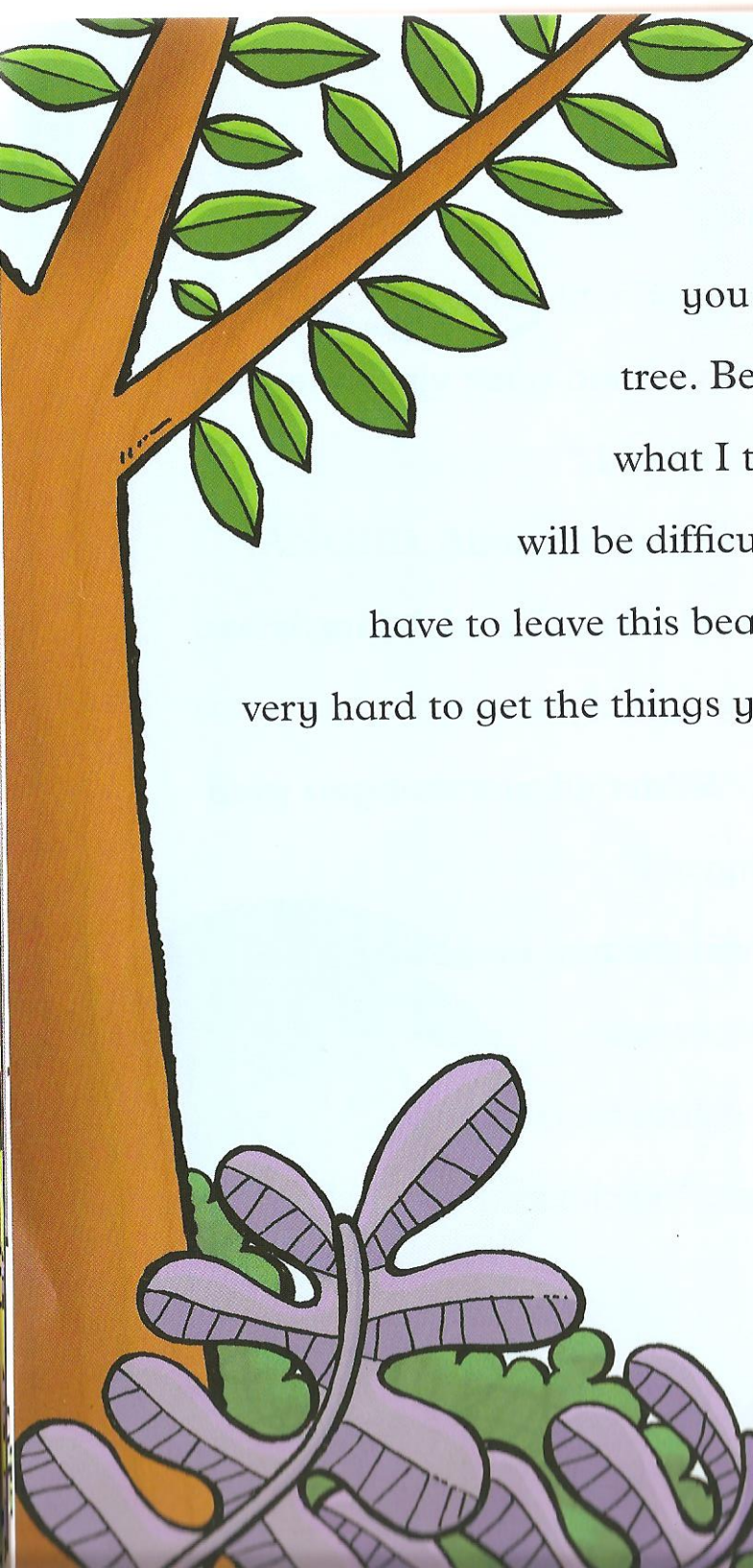
"Well, I'm naked, for one thing," said Adam, who
